How To Use:

Use Bore-tips to apply solvent, remove the fouling, clean the barrel, and then lubricate the surface of the bore. Easily clean your Bore-tips and reuse.



1. Apply a small amount of solvent to a Bore-tip and apply to the barrel. Allow the solvent time to work.



2. Brush the bore to break up any fouling. Apply more solvent if needed.



3. Remove the fouling with a clean Bore-tip. Wet with a little solvent and blot dry. Repeat until clean.



4. Dry the Barrel with a clean bore-tip. You can use another Bore-tip to lubricate the barrel.

*NOTE: Always make sure the firearm is unloaded before cleaning. If you lubricate the barrel, it must be dry swabbed before it is fired again. The bore should **ALWAYS** be clear and dry before firing.*

How To Clean:

All Swab-its® Firearm Cleaning Foam Swabs may be cleaned with either mineral spirits or soap and water. For faster cleaning we recommend using mineral spirits.

Dirty Bore-tip



First Squeeze the Bore-tip to blot out any excess solvent or dirt.

Soap and Water



Wash the Bore-tip with a grease cutting soap and warm water. Rinse when clean.

Mineral Spirits



Or, apply clean solvent and squeeze into an absorbent rag or paper towel.

Blot Dry



When clean, blot all the moisture away. Let dry and reuse.
